7.16 Declaration of Emergency Continuation of Virtual Board Meeting

Follow AB361 to consider the circumstances of the state of emergency and determine if the state of emergency continues to directly impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person. This amendment to Section 54953 of the Brown Act to allow virtual board meetings at least through January 1, 2024 under the following conditions:

1. The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency, and state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing.
2. The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.
3. The legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency and has determined, by majority vote, that, as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.

This declaration of emergency must be approved 30 days before each meeting.
